Recruitment Stage

This table shows the numbers of applications by candidates and the recruitment stages reached. The total number of applications made is therefore read from the total column on the <u>right hand side</u>. The totals in the recruitment data tables are based on the total number of applications received across all our vacancies in the reporting period.

Using the example below, a total of 59 applications were received. There were 29 interviews (total of columns 'Interview no job offer' and 'Job offered and accepted'). 30 applications did not reach the interview stage i.e. 'Applied only'. 19 job offers were accepted.
