This account was referred to me for taxation in terms of a document appended to the Law Agents' account dated 9th July 1976. The account was to be taxed on the basis of Agent and Client, third party (and) paying.

There were objections taken to a number of items contained in the account, the majority of which were accepted by the solicitors, and the only real point which was at issue was the objection taken by the Law Society to the charges made by the solicitor for pre-examinations, taken by him of the Pursuer and two witnesses and the forming up of a view of them, prior to the lodgement of the Legal Aid application. I was informed at the dict of taxation held on 26th July 1976 that no objection to the charges had been taken when the account had been submitted to the Law Society in May. I asked the solicitor if he could explain that he had been unable to respond to my enquiry concerning the account to the Trust 1976 until it had been referred to the Pursuer's solicitor. He said the taxation of the account had been delayed.

It was agreed at the meeting that this was done in May because of the urgency of the matter and that it had only been referred to the Law Society in July because the solicitor had been committed to another client. The solicitor claimed that there had been a conflict and thereafter arrangements had been made to refer the supporting witness. It was soon realised that no witness had been obtained after the supporting witness had been obtained. The solicitor had been granted the Legal Aid Application was late.

It was maintained on behalf of the Law Society that this was therefore a case in which Legal Aid had been sought after proceedings had been instituted and that therefore all work prior to the date of lodgement of the Legal Aid Application should be disallowed. The scope and general condition under which Legal Aid is granted are set out in the first four sections of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1975. In supplement to the Statutory provisions various Practice Notes have been provided. Contained in these Notes is a section headed "No payment without effective Legal Aid Certificate". It is there laid down that subject to certain exceptions "a solicitor can only be paid out of the fund for work done on behalf of his client during the time when his client held an effective Legal Aid Certificate" but it is specifically stated that he will be paid, notwithstanding that at the time his client did not have an effective certificate for inter alia "obtaining pre-announcements to establish a probable cause litigandi, provided they are used subsequently in the proceedings". It was not suggested in the present case that the pre-announcements produced in support of the legal aid application were not subsequently used in the proceedings and the defendant was granted legal aid so that these pre-announcements must have been accepted as assisting in the establishment of probable cause.

No distinction is drawn in the Practice Note between cases where the pre-announcements are obtained before or after the commencement of proceedings and it seems to be that these pre-announcements are always covered by the exception mentioned above and accordingly paid after the charge for the obtaining, framing and extending of the proceedings. I may say that I am reinforced in my view in so far as I only stand from the editor of the Journal of Section that it is his normal practice to allow such charges in similar cases.
